MEMORANDUM OF SOCIETY OF THE VISHWAKARMA SOCIAL EDUCATIONAL
AND CULTURAL SOCIETY NEW DELHI.

1. Name of the society:- Vishwakarma Social, Educational and Cultural Society New Delhi.
2. The Office of the society will be remain in U.T. of Delhi and at present will be in Flat No. 104 A/A-5 Paschim Vihar New Delhi.
3. Aims and objects of the Society.
 - i) To open and run school/Educational institutions/Craft or coaching centre in the U.T. of Delhi so as to bring the education within the reach of the poor, backward children. Special emphasize will be given to reach backward class(B/C), S/G, S/T or orphans, physically handicapped children, helpless.
 - ii) To provide adult and Basic education under modern technique pattern. and programme will be prepared to fight untouchability, Dowry system etc.
 - iii) To provide craft education to girls and women so that they may be self dependent, physically, mentally or socially.
 - iv) To help the poor and handicapped children persons by all the possible ways..
 - v) To provide constructive education i.e. to arrange for vocational studies.
 - vi) To prepare programme(including research studies) for welfare of Khadi and Gram Udyog for S/c, S/T Poor etc.
 - vii) To organise the Vishwakarma Samaj for uplift and and for the research studies (including their history and Culture) for the welfare of the samaj. Special programmes will be prepared to promote education to the students belonging to Vishwakarma Samaj by all possible ways.
 - viii) To arrange exhibitions, picnics, seminars, fares, meetings with concerned authorities and to arrange for all such competitions which will promote achieve the aims of the society such as Art, drawing, writing(including testing of any kind of knowledge) speech, music, wrestling, games and matches etc. competitions.
 - ix) to Organise social & cultural programmes like Ram Lila Drama, Kirtan, Bhajan, Akhand Kirtan/ Path and to celebrate the Lord Vishwakarma Day etc.

- xi To provide hostals, libraries etc and to publish books, maps, magazines etc. for the developments of aims and objects of the society.
- xii) To Acquire/manage land from D.D.A./Gram shabha or any other Govt. or Private body on purchase or in gift and to construct school, hostal, liberary, Dharamshala Mandir etc. and to manage the affairs.

" All the incomes, earnings, moveable or immveable properties of the society shall be solely utilised and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth in the Memorandum of the Society and no portion there of shall be paid or profits or in any manner whatsoever, to the present or past members of the society or to any person claiming throught any one or more of the present or the past members. No member of the society shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immoveable properties of the society or make any profit whatsoever by virtues of this membership."

quorum shall be required in the adjourned meetings. An emergent meeting of the general body may also be summoned on the written request of 3/5 members. The following business shall be transacted in these meetings

- i. To prepare annual programmes and policies.
- ii. To pass annual budget of the society.
- iii. To discuss and to decide all such other matters and issues which are directly or indirectly related to the affairs of the society.
- iv. To appoint an auditor who will annually inspect the account of the society's funds.

8. Governing Body :

There shall be a governing body of the society to look after and to manage the day-to-day affairs of the society. It shall consist of minimum 8 (Eight) and maximum 21 (Twenty one) members including the office bearers. The meeting of the governing body shall be held after one months with 1/3 quorum. No quorum shall be required in the adjourned meetings. An emergent meeting of the governing body may also be summoned on the written request of 2/5 members. The following business shall be transacted in these meetings :-

- a. To arrange if required Loan Advance etc. from the Bank individuals and financial institutions to run the society.
 - b. To take necessary steps for the implementation of all the programs and policies drawn by the General Body.
 - c. To accept Loan Grant in-add donation subscription supplementry subscription etc. from Govt. or any public.
 - d. To pass necessary expenditure to meet the day-to-day requirements of the society.
 - e. To take all such other legal steps which may appear beneficial for the smooth and better management of the society.
 - f. The following is the present structure of the Governing Body.
 1. president. 2. Vice-President
 3. General Secretary 4. Joint Secretary
 5. Cashier 6. Members from 3 to 16.

9. Office bearers and their duties :-

- a. President : i. He shall preside over all the meetings of general body and governing body.
ii. In case of equality of votes in any meetings he shall tender his casting votes.
iii. He shall supervise work of other office bearers from time to time.

b. Vice President:

During the absence of the president, he shall take the chair and usually he will assist the president.

c. General Secretary:

- i. He shall represent the society in all public and private office.
ii. He shall keep all types of record of the society including the register of the members containing there in the names, addresses and other brief particulars.
iii. He shall undertake all types of correspondence on behalf of the society,
iv. He shall convene the meeting of the General Body and Governing Body and shall also inform every member regarding time date and place of the meeting through a ten days earlier written notice.

d. Joint Secretary:

He shall assist the General Secretary.

e. Cashier:

He shall collect, subscriptions, gifts grant in aid donations from the members and general public and he shall also be responsible for keeping and maintenance of the true and correct accounts of the society's funds. Loans will also be collected by him.

10. Financial Year :

The financial Year of the society shall be from 1st April to 31st March every year.

11. Source of Income :-

Subscription, donations, grant-in-aid and gifts, fee etc. from the members and the general public shall be the source of income of the society.

12. Audit.

The society shall be get audited by any auditor appointed by the society annually.

13. Bank Account Operation :-

The funds of the society shall be kept in scheduled bank. The bank account shall be operated by the General Secretary and Treasurer with their joint signatures.

14. Election :-

The governing body of the society shall be elected for a term of two years in the general body meetings. The secret ballot system shall be the mode of election.

15. Annual List :

Every year a list of governing body office bearers and members shall be filed in the office of the registrar of societies, Delhi as required under section four (4) of S.R.Act. of 1860.

16. Legal Proceedings :-

The society may sue or be sued in the name of the president as required u/s of S.R.Act. of 1860.

17. Amendment :-

Any amendment in the memorandum of rules of this Society shall be carried out in accordance with procedure laid down u/s 12 and 12A of S.R.Act. of 1860.

18. Dissolution :-

This society may be dissolved in accordance with the procedure laid down u/s 13 and 14 of S.R.Act. of 1860.

All the provision of all the sections of S.R.Act. 1860 as applicable to the u.t. of Delhi shall apply to the society.
